

# EduQuest Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Who Designed EduQuest?** EduQuest was designed by Moore Interactive Education (MIE). MIE is a consulting firm formed by the husband and wife team of Shea Briggs Moore and Brett J. Moore. - 2. What age group is EduQuest appropriate for?** EduQuest has two programs. We have a K-2 Literacy Program and a 3-8 Creative Writing Program.
- 3. Does EduQuest align with S. Carolina’s State Learning Standards?** All of our programs align with North and South Carolina’s State Learning Standards. Please see each individual program for how the program meets state standards.
- 4. How long does it take to complete each EduQuest experience?** Our programs average 2 hours in length.
- 5. How much does EduQuest cost?** \$6.50 per student with a loaner wand. If the student would like to keep a permanent wand than the price is \$20.00 per student.
- 6. How do I organize my students to participate in EduQuest?** Students should be divided into mixed ability reading groups of 3-4.
- 7. Can I bring a chaperone to the program?** Yes, chaperones are welcome to come free of charge. Please encourage them to let the students problem solve on their own.
